

# Senior Lectureship (Medical) in Clinical Genetics

This new position is based in the Department of Molecular Medicine, an established Department in the School of Medicine contributing to teaching in the undergraduate courses. The research interests of the Department are varied with well established research in the fields of immunobiology, rheumatology, haematology, microbiology, infectious diseases and genetics.

A section of clinical genetics has been established in conjunction with Auckland Healthcare. Significant expansion of both academic and service aspects of clinical genetics has been funded. This new post will be the second academic post in clinical genetics.

Candidates must hold a medical qualification and be registerable in New Zealand together with a recognised postgraduate qualification in Clinical Genetics. They should have some experience in teaching undergraduate and postgraduate medical students and must have demonstrated an ability to undertake research in Clinical Genetics. They will be expected to pursue active research in this field. Clinical duties of up to 50% will be negotiated.

Commencing salary per annum will be established with in the range NZ\$70,000 - NZ\$91,000 plus supplements.
