How do I subscribe?

Subscription to HUM-MOLGEN is entirely free. Users connected to Internet can subscribe to the list by sending an E-mail to LISTSERV@NIC.SURFNET.NL with the message

```
subscribe HUM-MOLGEN first_name last_name(JMG)
```

For example, if your name is Paul Kennedy, then your E-mail message should read

```
subscribe HUM-MOLGEN Paul Kennedy(JMG)
```

There is no need to put anything in the "Subject" field of your E-mail message. Instructions will be returned to you automatically. Subscriptions can be ended by sending the message signoff HUM-MOLGEN to the list server (listserv@nic.surfnet.nl).
